We will hold a Remembrance Sunday Holy Communion service on the 8th of November at 10.45am and we will remember the names of the fallen as usual.

Services in the Community Hall

The Covid-19 regulations require churches to hold services in well ventilated locations. The only way we can comply with this is if we leave one of the church doors open while we worship. As you know, our church heating is not very efficient and leaving a door open will make the church too cold for most people. After consultation with the Standing Committee, we have decided that it would be sensible to hold most of our services during the winter months in the Community Hall. In the hall we will be able to ventilate hall and keep it warm at a lower cost. In addition, the space will allow for more people to attend. We plan, therefore, to hold services in church for the first three Sundays in November, one of which is Remembrance Sunday, and then start worshipping in the Hall from 22nd November onwards.
