

The History of Quarrington Community Hall

St Botolph's Community Hall was opened in 1932 as the church hall.

Such halls were opened in a time when they were often used as a focus of community life for meetings, social events such as barn dances and for private hire by citizens in the local community.

The hall is also used as a polling station.



The hall was renovated in 2014, with financial support from the Wren organisation and Lincolnshire CC, updating the kitchen and improving the facilities.
