This meets on the second Wednesday of each month in the Church Room at 2pm. Please speak to Rev Heather for more details.

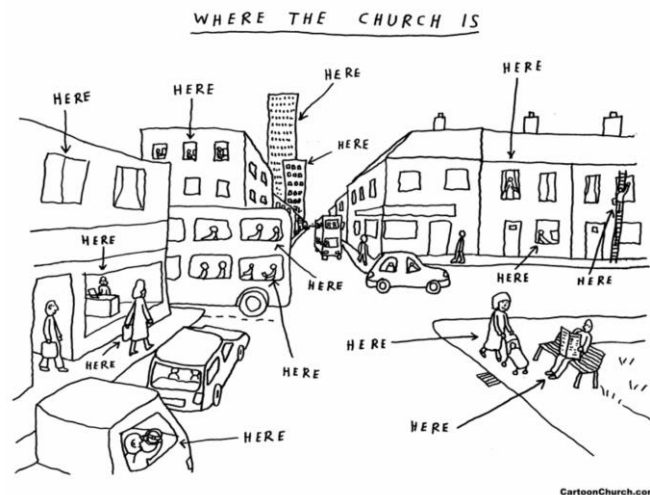
Men's Group

This will start on Saturday 30th March until Sunday 14th April. Please encourage families to take part. This year it will start at the Co-op on London Road so please collect your map from there.

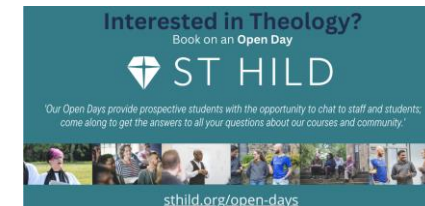
Interested in Theology?
